Along with a donated SIM card, Dave is now equipped to combat social isolation and manage his tenancy effectively keeping in touch with landlords and paying rent online.

Dave's journey reached another milestone when he secured a flat through the Salvation Army, arriving at just the right moment to complement the support he had received. Today, he stands as a confident individual who believes in his abilities, a transformation made possible by the collective efforts of various departments working in tandem to make a significant difference in his life.
